### **Monthly Trap Shoot – July 10, 2010**

Our monthly trap shoot for July will be on the 10th. Lunch will be provided. We also need a scorer or two; please let Jake Jacobs know if you can help. We hope to see you all there. Practice and squading starts at 9:00 AM. shoot for score starts at 10:00 AM. The shoot will be 100 singles, 100 handicap and 50 pairs of doubles.

### Awards

\$3.00 of every entry will go in the trophy pot, and will be returned to the shooters as follows:

- Doubles and Singles - each class shoots for total money divided by class.
- Handicap - 40% to Champ, 20% to each yardage group winner.

### FEES:

Targets: \$24.00 per 100 (Jr. & Sub Jr. \$12.00), ATA Daily Fee \$2.00, FTA Daily Fee \$2.00.

The “MIDDLE 50”, “50 STRAIGHT” and “100 STRAIGHT” continue with this shoot. The rules of these events are as follows:

- “*Middle 50*” - \$10 entry in Handicap Event, Anyone who runs the middle 50 in Handicap Event will win the pot. (Pot is @ \$160)
- “*50 Straight*” - \$5 entry (separately) in Singles & Doubles, Anyone who runs a 50 straight (first, middle, last) will win the pot (Pot is now at \$35.00).
- “*100 Straight*” No entry required. If anyone runs a 100 straight they will win \$50 To be eligible for any of the above, shooter MUST shoot in 2 events

After purse reaches \$500, half the entries will go into the Trap Fund. Ties Divide
